

OPEN LUNCH CAMPUS PERMISSION FORM Grades 9th – 12th ONLY

- 1. You must obtain parental permission if you wish to be eligible to drive and/or walk off the campus during your lunch break.
- 2. The car must be your own or belong to your family. You cannot drive another student's car.
- 3. You will park your car in the school parking lot. You will drive in a lawful and responsible manner. The speed limit in the parking lot is 10 MPH. Loitering in the parking lot will not be allowed.
- 4. Driving privileges are extended for you to drive to and from home or downtown for lunch. Drivers may not be driving around other areas of the School District.
- 5. The use of drugs or alcohol is strictly prohibited by law and school policy. Should the driving privilege increase the incidence of this problem, the privilege will be terminated for all students.
